- Our Company had negative cash flow in recent fiscals, details of which are given below. Sustained negative cash flow could adversely impact our business, financial condition and results of operations.
- Our Registered Office and one of our Showroom are not owned by us and we have only leave and license rights over them. In the event we lose such rights, our business, financial condition and results of operations, and cash flows could be adversely affected.
- Our gold jewellery business faces risks from market volatility and changing customer preferences. Fluctuations in commodity prices like gold could impact our costs and profitability. Evolving customer tastes influence product demand, necessitating continuous adaptation, to remain competitive.
- Our business is primarily concentrated in the central and northern part of India, especially around Delhi and its neighbouring states, i.e. Uttar Pradesh, Haryana and Uttarakhand and we are significantly dependent on these states for revenue generation. Any adverse development affecting such states may have an adverse effect on our business, prospects, financial condition and results of operations
- Our inability to identify market trends, and customer demand accurately, counter the challenges that the industry faces and maintain an optimal level of inventory may impact our operations adversely.

- We derive a significant portion of our revenue from the sale of chains and any reduction in demand or in the manufacturing of such product could have an adverse effect on our business, results of operations and financial condition.

कोलकाता में मंगलवार को भारत और अमेरिका के बीच हुए व्यापार समझौते के खिलाफ प्रदर्शन करते कांग्रेस के सदस्य।

विधान परिषद में हंगामे के बाद विपक्षी सदस्य निलंबित, मार्शल ने बाहर निकाला

पटना, 10 फरवरी (भाषा)।

बिहार विधान परिषद में मंगलवार को विपक्षी सदस्यों ने जोरदार हंगामा किया और अंततः सभापति के निर्देश पर मार्शल को उन सभी को सदन से बाहर ले जाना पड़ा।

सभापति अवधेश नारायण सिंह ने सदन में हंगामा कर रहे सदस्यों को बार-बार शांत रहने और सदन की कार्यवाही सुचारु रूप से चलने देने का आग्रह किया, लेकिन विपक्षी सदस्यों ने उनके अनुरोध को अनदेखा कर दिया और अंततः मार्शल बुलाकर ऐसे सदस्यों को बाहर किया गया। सभापति ने हंगामा कर रहे विपक्षी सदस्यों (एमएलसी) को दिनभर के लिए निलंबित भी कर दिया। इनमें से अधिकतर सदस्य राष्ट्रीय जनता दल (राजद) से हैं। सदन में हंगामा उस वक्त शुरू हुआ जब विपक्षी सदस्य राज्य में महिलाओं के खिलाफ अपराध के मामलों में बढोतरी होने का आरोप लगाते हुए मुख्यमंत्री नीतीश कुमार के इस्तीफे की मांग की और हंगामा किया। हंगामे की ही बीच सत्तारूढ़

जद (एकी) के मंत्री अशोक चौधरी और राजद के विधान परिषद सदस्य सुनील सिंह के बीच तीखी नोकझोंक भी देखी गई। कुछ ही देर में विपक्षी सदस्य आसन के समीप पहुंच गए, जिस पर भाजपा से मंत्री मंगल पांडे ने टिप्पणी की, 'इनका (हंगामा कर रहे सदस्यों का) व्यवहार बताता है कि ये सदन चलने नहीं देना चाहते।' सभापति ने हंगामा कर रहे विपक्षी सदस्यों से कहा कि अपनी सीट पर जाइए, सदन चलने दीजिए, या कम से कम आज के लिए बाहर चले जाइए। जब विपक्षी सदस्य नारेबाजी करते रहे और सभापति एवं सत्तापक्ष की ओर उंगलियां उठाते रहे, तब अवधेश नारायण सिंह ने कहा कि मार्शल बुलाकर सभी सदस्यों को सदन से बाहर निकाल दिया जाए। उन्होंने यह भी कहा कि इन सभी को आज के लिए सभा की कार्यवाही से निलंबित किया जाता है। निलंबित सदस्यों में विधान परिषद की नेता प्रतिपक्ष रावड़ी देवी, राजद के सुनील सिंह, अजय कुमार सिंह और भाकपा (माले) लिबरेशन के शशि यादव शामिल हैं।

झारखंड के बोकारो में बाहुबली की अवैध इमारत ढहाई गई

बोकारो, 10 फरवरी (भाषा)।

झारखंड के बोकारो में जेल में बंद बाहुबली विनोद कुमार उर्फ विनोद खोपड़ी द्वारा कथित तौर पर निर्मित एक अवैध इमारत को मंगलवार को ध्वस्त कर दिया गया। पुलिस ने यह जानकारी दी। उन्होंने बताया कि बोकारो इस्पात संयंत्र की जमीन पर बनी इस इमारत का इस्तेमाल कुमार अपने आवास-सह-कार्यालय के रूप में कर रहे थे। कुमार चास नगर निगम के महापौर पद के उम्मीदवार हैं, जहां 27 फरवरी को 47 अन्य नगर निकायों के साथ चुनाव होंगे। झारखंड में नगर निकाय चुनाव बिना किसी दलीय संबद्धता के होते हैं।

डीएसपी (बोकारो सिटी) आलोक रंजन ने बताया कि जयंत सिंह की हत्या की जांच के दौरान इस इमारत के अस्तित्व का पता चला। कुमार इस मामले में मुख्य आरोपी हैं और वर्तमान में जेल में बंद हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि विधुस से पहले सभी कानूनी प्रक्रियाओं का पालन किया गया था। कुमार को नोटिस दिया गया था और इमारत खाली करने के लिए एक सप्ताह का समय दिया गया था, लेकिन उन्होंने इमारत खाली नहीं की। कुमार के समर्थकों ने बोकारो स्टील प्लांट और पुलिस द्वारा चलाए गए ध्वंसीकरण अभियान को राजनीतिक रूप से प्रेरित बताया।

उन्होंने आरोप लगाया कि कुमार के प्रतिद्वंद्वियों ने नगर निगम चुनावों में उनकी जीत के डर से प्रशासन और इस्पात संयंत्र के अधिकारियों पर इमारत को ध्वस्त करवाने के लिए दबाव डाला। उन्होंने यह भी दावा किया कि उन्हें हत्या के मामले में फंसाया गया है और ध्वंसीकरण उनके चुनाव अभियान को पटरी से उतारने की साजिश का हिस्सा है।

शिक्षक मंचह के करीब 500 सदस्यों ने साल्ट लेक इलाके में करुणामयी से मार्च निकाला। हालांकि, उन्हें राज्य शिक्षा विभाग के मुख्यालय विकास भवन की ओर जाने से रोक दिया गया। प्रदर्शनकारी पारा शिक्षकों को पुलिसवालों से धक्का-मुक्की करते और राज्य के शिक्षा मंत्री ब्रज्य बसु से मुलाकात की मांग को लेकर

सड़क पर बैठे, लेकिन उनकी अपील ठुकरा दी गई। संगठन के एक सदस्य विजोन नरकर ने कहा कि पुलिस ने इलाके में प्रतिबंध आदेशों का हवाला दिया। मुझे हैरानी है कि प्रशासन को पांच सदस्यों वाले शिष्टमंडल को मंत्री या दूसरे वरिष्ठ अधिकारियों से मिलकर हमारी मांगों की सूची सौंपने की इजाजत देने से कौन रोक

कोलकाता, 10 फरवरी (भाषा)।

ओरल पोलियो टीका सुरक्षित, असरदार और दुनिया भर में पोलियो को समाप्त करने की कोशिशों के लिए ज़रूरी है, लेकिन टीके से बने पोलियो विषाणु के स्वरूप के उभार से निपटने के लिए बेहतर टीकाकरण (इम्यूनाइजेशन) की ज़रूरत है। अमेरिका स्थित जन स्वास्थ्य विशेषज्ञ ने इसकी जानकारी दी है।

भारत की मौजूदा स्थिति का ज़िक्र करते हुए, गेट्स फाउंडेशन के उप निदेशक डा आनंद शंकर बंधोपाध्याय ने कहा कि हाल के सालों में पोलियोविषाणु अलग-अलग फैलने वाले स्वरूप से लकवा फैलने का पता नहीं चला है, जो इस बात का संकेत है कि देश ह्यहाई रेगुलर टीकाकरण कवरेज बनाए रखने में कामयाब रहा है। खास बात यह है कि भारत को मार्च 2014 में पोलियो-मुक्त घोषित किया गया था। बंधोपाध्याय ने अमेरिका के सिगएल से पीओआई को बताया कि ओरल पोलियो वैक्सीन सुरक्षित, असरदार, सस्ती और देने में आसान है। रेगुलर इम्यूनाइजेशन और बड़े पैमाने पर टीकाकरण अभियान के जरिए इसके इस्तेमाल से दुनिया भर में बच्चों में पोलियो विषाणु का संक्रमण खत्म हो गया है और लकवे को रोकना गया है, दुनिया का 99.9 फीसद हिस्सा पोलियो-मुक्त है।

चंडीगढ़, 10 फरवरी : हरियाणा के मुख्यमंत्री नायब सिंह सैनी ने दावा किया है कि प्रदेश में 20,31,367 बुजुर्गों को सामाजिक सुरक्षा पेंशन दी जा रही है। उन्होंने यह भी दावा किया है कि भाजपा के 11 वर्ष के शासनकाल में बुढ़ापा पेंशन में 2200 रुपये की बढ़ोतरी की गई है जबकि वार्षिक सालाना आय में एक लाख रुपये की बढ़ोतरी की गई है। मुख्यमंत्री ने मंगलवार को यहां प्रेस कॉन्फ्रेंस में यह दावा किया है। उन्होंने अलग-अलग योजनाओं के तहत 56.34 लाख लाभार्थियों के सीधे बैंक खातों में 1431 करोड़ रुपये की राशि जारी की। मुख्यमंत्री नायब सिंह सैनी ने विपक्षी दलों के नेताओं को बुढ़ापा पेंशन पर लोगों को गुमराह करने, भ्रम फैलाने और झूठ बोलने का आरोप लगाया। मुख्यमंत्री ने कहा कि कांग्रेस के समय 1992 में बुढ़ापा पेंशन प्राप्त करने वाले परिवार की सालाना आय 10,000 रुपये तय की थी और इनेलो ने इसे 10,000 रुपये ही रखा। कांग्रेस के 10 साल के शासनकाल में चुनाव से पहले 2013 में सालाना आय दो लाख रुपये की गई, जिसे तत्कालीन

मुख्यमंत्री नायब सिंह सैनी ने कहा कि रजिस्ट्रार ऑफ इंडिया पोर्टल से अक्टूबर, 2024 से तकनीकी कारण से हरियाणा को स्वर्ग सिंघार चुके बुजुर्गों का डाटा नहीं मिला था। मगर नवंबर, 2025 में यह डाटा मिला तो 1.03 लाख स्वर्ग सिंघार चुके बुजुर्गों की तरफ एक साथ बंद करनी पड़ी। उन्होंने कहा कि 37000 बुजुर्ग ऐसे हैं, जिनकी आय 60 साल से कम थी मगर डाटा में छेड़छाड़ कर उन्होंने बुढ़ापा

पेंशन लगावा ली। ऐसे बुजुर्गों की पेंशन भी स्थगित की है और डाटा वेरीफाई करावा है। जिन्होंने डाटा के साथ छेड़छाड़ की है, उनके खिलाफ कार्रवाई हो रही है। दैनिक सवेरा ने पूछा कि पोर्टल में तो प्रावधान है कि 60 साल की उम्र पूरी होते ही विभागा की तरफ से बुजुर्ग से पूछा जाता है कि पेंशन लेनी है या नहीं तो यह उम्र कैसे कम हो गई? मुख्यमंत्री नायब सिंह सैनी ने जवाब दिया कि आधार कार्ड

में उन्होंने उम्र बढ़ाई है। इसलिए उनकी जांच की जा रही है। अगर सही पाई गई तो स्थगित पेंशन शुरू हो जाएगी। मुख्यमंत्री ने कहा कि 39000 बुजुर्ग ऐसे हैं, जिनकी पारिवारिक आय स्थानीय कमेटी, सेक्टर कमेटी से सत्यापित नहीं हो पाई। इसलिए जब तक सत्यापन नहीं हो जाता तब तक उनकी पेंशन भी स्थगित रहेगी। सत्यापन होने के बाद उनकी पेंशन भी जारी कर दी जाएगी।

मुख्यमंत्री नायब सिंह सैनी ने कहा कि वृद्धावस्था पेंशन पर आय सीमा प्रदेश की बीजेपी सरकार ने नहीं लगाई। प्रदेश में वृद्धावस्था पेंशन पर पहली बार 10 हजार रुपये वार्षिक आय सीमा 13 अगस्त, 1992 को लगाई गई थी। उस समय प्रदेश में कांग्रेस की सरकार थी। उस समय वृद्धावस्था पेंशन भी 100 रुपये
